Post 95 Finance Officer Don Happy reported he had added eight hundred forty six dollars and thirteen cents (\$846.13) bringing the total amount to eleven Thousand four hundred eleven dollars and thirty two cents (\$11,411.32)

Since Edward R. Jones only takes CD's out in one thousand (\$1000) dollar increments Post 95 Finance Officer Don Happy took out a new CD in the amount of eleven thousand (\$11,000) dollars at four point two percent (4.2%) and would mature on 10/23/25.

Post 95 Finance Officer Don Happy put the excess funds four hundred eleven dollars and thirty two cents (\$411.32) in a money market account.
